

2018 “MLK Wildcat Classic”

Mt Si HS (1-2-3 courts) / Mt Si FC / Twin Falls / Chief Kanim MS (1-2 courts)/ NBE / CVES / TRES /Si View CC

RULES: HS Rules of Play as **Modified below:**

- **Game Times:** Games shall consist of two 20-minute halves – running clock – except **stop clock last two minutes of each half** as long as neither team leads by 20 points.
- **4th and 5th Boys/Girls: Man to man only! No Front/Backcourt Zone Defenses allowed**
- **Half time:** shall be 3-5 minutes
- **Pre-Game:** Minimum pre-game warm-up of 5 minutes
- A 28.5" ball will be used for the 4th, 5th & 6th grades and regulation size ball for 7th & 8th grades
- **Timeouts:** 3 Full time outs per game
- **Overtimes** shall be 2 minutes (1st O/T) - 1 minutes (2nd O/T) – Sudden Death (3 O/T)
 - b). Teams will get 1 time-out per overtime.
- **Technical fouls** automatic two points and possession of ball. **2 technical fouls during a game on any one Participant, player or coach, will result in ejection from that game and that participant must leave view of the court and will not be eligible for the next scheduled game for that particular team.**
- **Mercy Rule: Backcourt press is not allowed by leading team after 20-point difference** in the score has been reached. If the lead shrinks to 15 points or less, the leading team may again backcourt press but only until the 20 point difference has been reached.
- If a team is up by 20 or more points in the second half, the clock will continue to run the last 2 minutes of the second half, except for timeouts, unless the point differential is brought to 10 points or less.
- Player’s last name along with the jersey number must be on the official roster or the official score sheet before the first game to be eligible for any games in the tournament.
- **Home Team: (coin toss) is responsible to keep official scorebook.** Home team will be the team listed on the bottom of the bracket or the second team listed in pool play.
- **Visiting Team: will provide a backup timekeeper.** Instructions on clock will be provided if necessary (We have timekeepers scheduled, but just in case there is a conflict, please have a backup timekeeper available).
- Each player may participate on only one team per division but may play up in a higher division **within the same basketball program or organization /school program.**
- *Coaches are responsible for the actions/behavior of their fans and may be asked by officials to keep fans in line to avoid fan’s ejection at the officials’ discretion. Fans that are ejected from a game must leave view of the court and may not return for the next scheduled game for that particular team and will not receive a refund.*
- **Seeding for Monday’s Championship Brackets will be determined by the following criteria:**
 - a). Win/Loss Record
 - b). Head-to-head Play
 - c). Total Point Differential with a maximum of 15 points per game
 - d). Total Points Allowed
 - e). Total Points Scored

Gate Charges:

\$6.00/Adult per day \$3 Senior/Military \$3.00/Child per day (Middle School and under)

- Teams are allowed **1 head coach and 1 scorekeeper or assistant coach** “Free” admission.

*There will be school monitors at each gym. Any game related issues that cannot be resolved between coaches and officials will result in a decision made by the tournament directors. **That decision will be final.***
